Seminar was organised by the National Centre for Health Promotion and Education in collaboration with project Co-ordinators from Federal Association of Company Health Insurance Funds (BKK, Germany).

16 representatives from the Ministry of Social Security and Labour, Board of the State Social Insurance Fund, State Labour Inspectorate, Lithuanian Confederation of Industrialists, companies, trade-unions and regional public health centres took

place in the seminar. The main objective to develop Workplace Health Promotion activities in Lithuania was achieved.

Director of the National Centre for Health Promotion and Education Mr Zenonas Javtokas in the opening of the seminar presented initial steps of WHP in Lithuania.

Dr. Alfons Schröder, Head of Department of Health from BKK introduced participants with ENWHP and its agenda for today. Dr. Uwe Brandenburg, Head of Ergonomics from Volkswagen AG, showed how they deal with health at the worksite, introduced examples of good practices in his company.

In participants opinion, the seminar was a great success and very practical. Representatives from private oil company “Mazeikiu nafta” and trade union of Lithuanian nursing specialists in collaboration with the National Centre for Health Promotion and Education were expected to take initial steps in developing a WHP forum in Lithuania.
