New ENWHP Standard

ENWHP is launching a new Standard for accrediting good practice in workplace health promotion in June 2021. Based on more than 20 years of identifying and evaluating Models of Good Practice as well as a number of national award schemes, the ENWHP Standard is the first European Accreditation system to be made available to companies and organisations who wish to gain recognition for their activities in the field

Taking part in the ENWHP's European WHP Standard should be seen as a developmental process for any



Training for WHP

The ENWHP members have developed a number of training courses related to WHP over the years. These have come from European projects taking place in a number of countries and funded by a number of different EU programmes.

These have focused on a range of target groups such as health professionals, and company level actors who wish to implement WHP.

They have focused on a range of issues - general health promotion,

applicant organisation. The Standard has three levels - Bronze, Silver, and Gold. Applying for the Standard at any level involves providing evidence that your organisation is active in a range of areas and is meeting certain criteria in those areas.

More information on the Standard will be available on the Website in July and all newsletter recipients will receive full notification of the details of the Standard as soon as they are published.
